QUICK START GUIDE PanaCast[®] ePTZ App (Windows PC)

This document describes how to set up and run the PanaCast[®] ePTZ (Pan, Tilt, Zoom) app with 3rd party collaboration applications on a Windows PC. This virtual camera app enables local control of digital pan, tilt and zoom within the video stream of a PanaCast 2 camera connected to the PC handling the web conference connection. It helps remote participants have an even more detailed and richer collaboration experience. It works with Skype[®], Skype[®] for Business, Cisco WebEx[®], Citrix[®] GoToMeeting[®], Zoom, Google[®] Hangouts[®] and more.

Requirements

Windows 7, 8, 8.1 or 10

Instructions

Step 0: Download and Install PanaCast ePTZ App Download the PanaCast ePTZ app from: <u>getpanacast.com/download</u>

Step 1: Enabling PanaCast ePTZ App

- Make sure your PanaCast camera is connected to a fully powered USB Select webcam: 3.0 port and powered on (if not use the power adapter included)
- Go to the Video Settings of your collaboration app
- Select "PanaCast ePTZ" as your webcam in the drop down menu
- The PanaCast ePTZ is auto-launched on selection

Step 2: Using PanaCast ePTZ

- PanaCast ePTZ runs alongside 3rd party video collaboration applications and is used to manipulate the panoramic video stream of a PanaCast 2 camera connected to the PC handling the web conference connection (Figure 1)
- Click on the PanaCast ePTZ app to perform Pan, Tilt, and Zoom functions
- To exit the app, right click on the ePTZ app icon in the task menu and click on exit to quit out of the app

Step 3: Using Pan, Tilt, Zoom Gestures

Standard multi-touch gestures allow you to easily manipulate the video while in a PanaCast session. For example, Figure 2 shows the PanaCast 2 video stream zoomed into the whiteboard.
